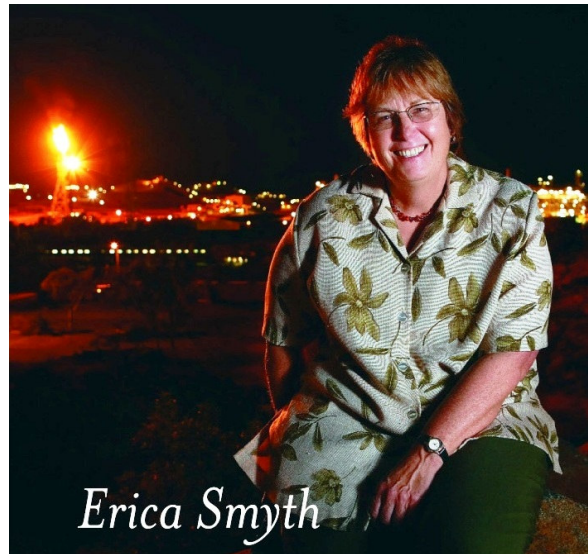
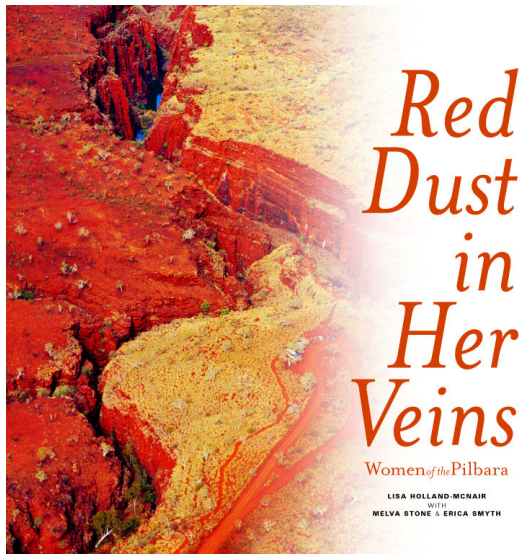
Dr. Erica Smyth
