



LCA WA District Inc. District Vision 2000 Music Scholarship Rules

1. NAME

This scholarship shall be called THE VISION 2000 CHURCH MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of the scholarship shall be to encourage organists or musicians to further develop their musical talent so as to more effectively contribute to the worship life of the congregations of the LCA WA District.

3. ADMINISTRATION

- a. The scholarship shall be awarded annually to a person or persons selected by the Church Council, its Executive or appointees, from applications received. In the event that no scholarship is awarded in any one year, two scholarships may be awarded in the following year, or the amount of the scholarship may be increased in that year.
- b. The use of the scholarship shall commence within twelve months of allocation, and the Church Council, its Executive or appointees shall require evidence of enrolment in a suitable course and a report upon completion of the course.
- c. Applications for the scholarship shall be forwarded to the Secretary of the LCA WA District no later than 30th September each year. Applicants shall be members of the LCA WA District who are practising or potential organists or musicians in one of the congregations of the LCA WA District.
- d. Applications shall be accompanied by references from the pastor and chairman or elder of the congregation of which the applicant is a member. An outline of the intended use to which the scholarship money will be put is to be included with the application.

4. RECEIPTS

The scholarship shall be funded by an annual grant from the "LCA WA District Home Mission Fund", the amount being determined from time to time by the LCA WA District Church Council, but not being less than \$500.00 per annum.
