Cost Estimates

1. Nairobi Accommodation (2 x nights) at Intercontinental Hotel US\$**235** per night for double/twin room. This includes breakfast. Single room is US\$195 per night.
2. Nairobi tour bus US \$**12** per head plus another US\$10 per head for entry to elephant orphanage; and maybe the same for the giraffe park.
3. Bus to Arusha US\$**26** per head.
4. Visa fees entry to Kenya US\$25 per head, Visa entry to Tanzania US\$50 per head.
5. Accommodation Kibo Palace (5 x nights) US\$**200** for double/twin. Single supplement will be another US\$**55** per head. This cost includes evening meal and breakfast.
6. No accommodation costs at St Judes (2 x nights) for Rotarians; the meal cost is US\$15 per head per day. **If you undertake a home visit (recommended!) it is normal practise to take a home pack prepared by St Judes with you. This costs US\$30.**
7. Safari cost is US\$**1890** per head covering all meals, guide, vehicle and accommodation (4 x nights)
8. Evening meals not covered in above include Nairobi (2) and at St Judes where we generally go out for at least one evening meal. A few lunches will need to be purchased depending on your fancy. Breakfasts are excellent so you can load up at the start of the day.
9. From the airport to the hotel in Nairobi costs US\$30 (can be shared) and from the hotel in Arusha to Kilimanjaro airport car hire is US\$50 (again can be shared)
10. Other costs to cover are basically drinks (not really expensive and the wine from South Africa is good) and whatever you might want to buy by way of souvenirs.

11. There are costs for tips; US\$20 per head for the driver on the Mamba visit; US\$40 per head for the safari and small US\$1 tips for porters.
