of me JANE ELIZABETH JONES late of Scarborough in the County of York but now of No 24 Saint Martins Road in the County of Surrey Widow I appoint my sons John Edmund Jones of the City of York Solicitor and Arthur Spottiswood Jones of the City of Gloucester Architect to be the EXECUTORS and trustees of this my will. I give and bequeath all my personal estate whatsoever and wheresoever (after paying thereout my funeral and testamentary expenses and debts and the legacy hereinafter bequeathed) to my daughters Catherine Miller and Jane Brearey Jones absolutely in equal shares for their respective sole and separate use I give to my said son Arthur Spottiswood Jones the sum of twenty pounds And I declare that the said John Edmund Jones shall be entitled to charge and shall be paid out of the trust premises for all business done by him in relation to the trust premises in like manner as he would have been entitled to charge the trustees for the same if not being himself a trustee he had been employed by them to do such business as their solicitor And I devise all estates vested in me as a -trustee or mortgagee unto the said John Edmund Jones and Arthur Spottiswood Jones subject to the trusts and equities affecting the same respectively IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my hand this tenth day of January one thousand eight hundred and eighty three - J E JONES - Signed by the testatrix Jane .Elizabeth Jones as and for her last will and testament in the presence of us both present at the same time who at her request in her sight and presence and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses
