



Margaret Mary Easton Music Scholarship

Sister Margaret Mary (Anne) Eaton was professed on 25 July 1926. She was passionate about music and tutored students piano, piano accordion, guitar, violin, recorder and percussion instruments. Sister Margaret was a very talented musician and artist. She obtained her Associate of the London College of Music (ALCM) from Trinity College, London, and her Associate diploma in Music, Australia (AmusA), from the University of Western Australia.

Scholarship for Musical Aptitude

This scholarship will be offered to an incoming Year 7 or Year 8 student who is an outstanding musician in their own right and who displays:

- Substantial musical aptitude inclusive of:
 - Practical skills equal to or above Grade Three A.M.E.B.
 - Theory skills equal to or above Grade Two A.M.E.B.
- A high level of performance on their chosen instrument;
- A history of commitment to their chosen instrument;
- A willingness to participate in the extra curricular activities associated to the music program at the College; and
- Ability to adhere and uphold the ethos of the College.

The scholarship is for full payment of musical tuition consisting of eight 30 minute lessons per term for the tenure of the student's time at the College.

The selection process will consist of completion of the application package by the candidate followed by an interview with a panel and an audition. At this time, reading skills will be tested through sight reading tests and an aural test will be conducted to assess pitch, rhythm and melody.

This scholarship is subject to review and monitoring on a term basis with a written report being completed by the tutor each semester. The scholarship can be withdrawn if requirements are not met. It is an expectation of the College that the scholarship recipient will complete a minimum of three years of the tenure period.
