

CONTRACT: Wireless Access for Boarding House Students

Connecting students' personal notebook computers to the wireless network at Iona Presentation College will give students access to the Internet and the myinternet suite of products including mydesktop, myclasses, mymail and myportfolio. This connection is via the Catholic Education Network (CathEdNet) and the same level of Internet access that applies to all students while using the college computers will extend to personal notebook use. This means that all Internet activity is logged and filtered by centrally applied monitoring and filtering software.

For security reasons, no login access to the College servers and mapping of home drives will be given. Furthermore, no access will be given to the College printers, meaning that students will need to transfer documents from their notebook computer to a hard-wired College desktop computer before they can print. This transfer may be done by either external USB memory sticks or by the use of the myinternet portal.

Students wishing to have their personal notebook computers enabled to access the Wireless Network at Iona Presentation College must have their notebook made compliant from a security perspective and will need to give permission for the following.

1. *To allow easy tracking of the computer within the network, the Notebook Computer will be renamed in the computer settings, to the student's own name.*
2. *Any existent anti-virus or Internet Security software that may be running on the notebook computer will be removed (un-installed) and replaced with the College's McAfee Antivirus Software. There will be no licensing cost associated with this installation. As long as the student is enrolled at Iona, she will be covered by the license agreement as signed by the Catholic Education Office of Western Australia and McAfee Network Associates Ltd. This software will need to be removed from the notebook computer when the student leaves the College.*
3. *Wireless connection settings in the Operating System will be altered to allow a secure connection to the wireless network.*
4. *Proxy settings in the Internet options of Internet Explorer will be set up to ensure access via the CathEdNet connection. Without these no access is possible. These settings will interfere with any connections that may exist on the laptop for private home Internet connections and students who take the notebook home and wish to use it on their home Internet connections will need to refer to an online document on the myinternet portal to learn how to enable and disable this as needed.*
5. *The setting for Microsoft's Automatic updates on the notebooks will be altered to be downloaded and automatically installed, from the College's Windows Update Server as opposed to the live Internet. This will be done to ensure a more rapid deployment of updates. Updates will be applied to the Windows Operating System and all versions of Microsoft Office.*

All of the above changes will be carried out by the IT staff at the college. None of these setting are to be changed as this will compromise the notebook's ability to connect to the Wireless Network. If you have any questions about this policy please contact the IT Manager at the College.

I have read all of the above and agree to have all the necessary changes made to my notebook as needed. I understand that I must strongly adhere to the College's Communication & Information Technology Acceptable Use Policy, as outlined in the diary, which I have also read and accepted. Failure to do so will result in immediate removal of my access.
