FEES AND CONDITIONS

Fees are payable one term in advance. Iona instrumental fee rates are set by the Western Australian Music Teachers Association and are adjusted according to the rate set by the Association. Fees are \$240 per term for individual lessons (eight, thirty-minute lessons). Please note that the fee rate was correct as of November 2010.

Individual tuition consists of eight, thirty-minute lessons per term. Longer lessons can be negotiated with the tutor and are recommended for advanced students

The instrumental tutor will issue accounts for music lessons approximately two weeks prior to the commencement of lessons.

Fees are payable directly to the instrumental tutor. Under no circumstances will they be accepted by the College Reception or the College Music Teachers.

Fees are payable within fourteen days of the account being issued. In the event that the account is not paid by the due date and alternative arrangements have not been made, a late fee of \$40 will be charged. If payment is not made within fourteen days, tutors reserve the right to suspend lessons until payment is received.

In the event that fees increase, parents will be notified one term in advance.

It is assumed that students who enrol in private instrumental music lessons will continue these lessons for the length of their time at the College.

One term's notice, in writing, is required to cease music lessons. Failure to do so will result in one term's fees being charged.

Shared lessons are only available with certain instruments to students in Years 7 and 8, and subject to tutor's advice and special conditions.

It is strongly recommended that students and parents discuss the commencement of a new instrument with the Music School before completing the Enrolment Form. Scholarships and Bursaries are available for some instruments. Scholarship auditions will be held in Term 4 for the commencement of tuition the following year.

MUSIC LESSONS

Lessons are scheduled during school hours on a rotational basis. It is the student's responsibility to check her lesson times in advance and attend her lessons on the scheduled day and on time. Timetables will be published on a term-by-term basis. Non-attendance, without prior notice to the tutor, will result in forfeiture of that lesson.

If the student is sick, the instrumental tutor must be notified directly by 8.30 am on the day of her lesson, otherwise her lesson will not be rescheduled. If a lesson is scheduled during a subject assessment, it is the student's responsibility to inform her instrumental tutor well before the day of her lesson so her lesson can be rescheduled. If a student misses five lessons in any term, without notice, they will be given a Friday detention.

MUSIC STUDIES DIARY

Students enrolled in the Instrumental Music Program will be issued with a Music Studies Diary at their first lesson. The cost of the diary is \$5, which is payable to the Music School. The purpose of the Music Studies Diary is for the tutor to record weekly practice requirements and upcoming lesson times, to communicate with parents and for students to keep a weekly practice record.

PURCHASING MUSIC BOOKS

The photocopying of music is illegal. The AMCOS Copyright Licence held by the College does not allow the copying of print music for purposes of private music teaching. Tutors will inform parents via the Music Diary as to which music books are required. Parents are responsible for the purchase of these materials.

MUSIC REPORTS

A music report will be issued for each student at the end of Semester 1 and Semester 2. This report will give parents and the student valuable feedback in regards to the student's progress.
