DEFINITION OF CLASSES: CONFORMATION

1. **Baby Puppy**

Dogs of 3 and under 6 months of age.

Minor Puppy

Dogs of 6 and under 9 months of age.

Puppy

Dogs of 6 and under 12 months of age.

Junior

Dogs of 9 and under 18 months of age.

Intermediate

Dogs of 18 and under 36 months of age.

Novice

Dogs of 6 months of age or over which have not won first prize at any Parade/Open Show or Championship Show excluding wins in Baby Puppy and Local Classes.

Graduate

Dogs of 6 months of age or over which have not won a Challenge Certificate.

Limit

Dogs over 12 months of age which are not Champions nor have gained sufficient points to qualify as a Champion.

Note: The qualifications for the NOVICE, GRADUATE and LIMIT classes, shall only include "wins up to and including the day before the date of entry close".

State Breed

Dogs six (6) months of age or over whelped in the State or Territory in which it is exhibited.

Australian Bred

Dogs six (6) months of age or over whelped in Australia.

Open

All dogs six (6) months of age or over, and of a breed or variety recognised by the Australian National Kennel Council.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES: CONFORMATION

1. **Baby Puppy**

Dogs of 3 and under 6 months of age.

Minor Puppy

Dogs of 6 and under 9 months of age.

Puppy

Dogs of 6 and under 12 months of age.

Junior

Dogs of 9 and under 18 months of age.

Intermediate

Dogs of 18 and under 36 months of age.

Novice

Dogs of 6 months of age or over which have not won first prize at any Parade/Open Show or Championship Show excluding wins in Baby Puppy and Local Classes.

Graduate

Dogs of 6 months of age or over which have not won a Challenge Certificate.

Limit

Dogs over 12 months of age which are not Champions nor have gained sufficient points to qualify as a Champion.

Note: The qualifications for the NOVICE, GRADUATE and LIMIT classes, shall only include "wins up to and including the day before the date of entry close".

State Breed

Dogs six (6) months of age or over whelped in the State or Territory in which it is exhibited.

Australian Bred

Dogs six (6) months of age or over whelped in Australia.

Open

DEFINITION OF CLASSES: CONFORMATION

1. **Baby Puppy**

Dogs of 3 and under 6 months of age.

Minor Puppy

Dogs of 6 and under 9 months of age.

Puppy

Dogs of 6 and under 12 months of age.

Junior

Dogs of 9 and under 18 months of age.

Intermediate

Dogs of 18 and under 36 months of age.

Novice

Dogs of 6 months of age or over which have not won first prize at any Parade/Open Show or Championship Show excluding wins in Baby Puppy and Local Classes.

Graduate

Dogs of 6 months of age or over which have not won a Challenge Certificate.

Limit

Dogs over 12 months of age which are not Champions nor have gained sufficient points to qualify as a Champion.

Note: The qualifications for the NOVICE, GRADUATE and LIMIT classes, shall only include "wins up to and including the day before the date of entry close".

State Breed

Dogs six (6) months of age or over whelped in the State or Territory in which it is exhibited.

Australian Bred

Dogs six (6) months of age or over whelped in Australia.

Open

All dogs six (6) months of age or over, and of a breed or variety recognised by the Australian National Kennel Council.

Note: 1 Only winners of Ordinary Classes 2 to 11 may compete for Challenge Certificates.

Note 2: The Standard numbering as above for male classes - bitch classes to be numbered as above with the letter "A" (e.g. 1A, 2A etc.).

Veteran

Separate classes may be offered for Veterans at fixtures:-

A. Seven (7) years and under ten (10) years.

B. Ten (10) years and over.

Note: A Veteran must be entered and exhibited n at least one ordinary class before it can compete for a Challenge Certificate or any special prize which is not specifically awarded for the Veteran Class. Neutered exhibits may compete in Veteran Class.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES: AGILITY

Qualifications up to and including the date of closing of entry shall count as eligibility to compete in any Class.

Novice Agility

For dogs which are not eligible for the title of Agility Dog (AD)

Novice Competition

May be provided for dogs of any breed or either sex who have gained the title of CD and have not attained a qualifying score in Open Class.

Open Agility

For dogs of either sex which have qualified and applied for the title of Agility Dog (AD), Agility Dog Excellent (ADX) or Agility Dog Master (ADM)

Master Agility

For dogs of either sex which have qualified and applied for the title of Agility Dog Excellent (ADX) or Agility Dog Master (ADM).

Note: It is not compulsory for clubs to offer a Master Class at an Agility Trial.

The following Jumping Classes are optional and may be approved by the Canine Control.

Novice Jumping

For dogs 18 months of age and over and of either sex which are not eligible for the title of Jumping Dog (JD)

Note: 1 Only winners of Ordinary Classes 2 to 11 may compete for Challenge Certificates.

Note 2: The Standard numbering as above for male classes - bitch classes to be numbered as above with the letter "A" (e.g. 1A, 2A etc.).

Veteran

Separate classes may be offered for Veterans at fixtures:-

A. Seven (7) years and under ten (10) years.

B. Ten (10) years and over.

Note: A Veteran must be entered and exhibited n at least one ordinary class before it can compete for a Challenge Certificate or any special prize which is not specifically awarded for the Veteran Class. Neutered exhibits may compete in Veteran Class.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES: AGILITY

Qualifications up to and including the date of closing of entry shall count as eligibility to compete in any Class.

Novice Agility

For dogs which are not eligible for the title of Agility Dog (AD)

Novice Competition

May be provided for dogs of any breed or either sex who have gained the title of CD and have not attained a qualifying score in Open Class.

Open Agility

For dogs of either sex which have qualified and applied for the title of Agility Dog (AD), Agility Dog Excellent (ADX) or Agility Dog Master (ADM)

Master Agility

For dogs of either sex which have qualified and applied for the title of Agility Dog Excellent (ADX) or Agility Dog Master (ADM).

Note: It is not compulsory for clubs to offer a Master Class at an Agility Trial.

The following Jumping Classes are optional and may be approved by the Canine Control.

Novice Jumping

For dogs 18 months of age and over and of either sex which are not eligible for the title of Jumping Dog (JD)

Note: 1 Only winners of Ordinary Classes 2 to 11 may compete for Challenge Certificates.

Note 2: The Standard numbering as above for male classes - bitch classes to be numbered as above with the letter "A" (e.g. 1A, 2A etc.).

Veteran

Separate classes may be offered for Veterans at fixtures:-

A. Seven (7) years and under ten (10) years.

B. Ten (10) years and over.

Note: A Veteran must be entered and exhibited n at least one ordinary class before it can compete for a Challenge Certificate or any special prize which is not specifically awarded for the Veteran Class. Neutered exhibits may compete in Veteran Class.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES: AGILITY

Qualifications up to and including the date of closing of entry shall count as eligibility to compete in any Class.

Novice Agility

For dogs which are not eligible for the title of Agility Dog (AD)

Novice Competition

May be provided for dogs of any breed or either sex who have gained the title of CD and have not attained a qualifying score in Open Class.

Open Agility

For dogs of either sex which have qualified and applied for the title of Agility Dog (AD), Agility Dog Excellent (ADX) or Agility Dog Master (ADM)

Master Agility

For dogs of either sex which have qualified and applied for the title of Agility Dog Excellent (ADX) or Agility Dog Master (ADM).

Note: It is not compulsory for clubs to offer a Master Class at an Agility Trial.

The following Jumping Classes are optional and may be approved by the Canine Control.

Novice Jumping

For dogs 18 months of age and over and of either sex which are not eligible for the title of Jumping Dog (JD)

Open Jumping

For dogs of either sex which have qualified and applied for the title of Jumping Dog (JD) or Jumping Dog Excellent (JDX)

Master Jumping

For dogs of either sex which have qualified and applied for the title of Jumping Dog Excellent (JDX) or Jumping Dog Master (JDM)

DEFINITION OF CLASSES: OBEDIENCE

Qualifications up to and including the date of closing of entry shall count as eligibility to compete in any Class.

Novice Class

For dogs, 6 months of age or over, and of either sex which are not eligible for the title of Companion Dog (CD).

Encouragement Class

For dogs that have already worked in Novice Class but not gained a Qualifying Score may enter the Encouragement Class.

Novice Competition

May be provided for dogs of any breed or either sex who have gained the title of Companion Dog (CD) and have not attained a qualifying score in Open Class.

Open Class

For dogs of either sex which have qualified for the title of Companion Dog (CD) in Novice Class.

Open Competition

For dogs of any breed or either sex who have gained a qualification towards the title of Utility Dog (UD). Dogs with a qualification towards a UD title will be ineligible to enter the Open Class when an Open Competition is offered.

Utility Class

For dogs of either sex which have qualified for the title of Companion Dog Excellent (CDX) in Open Class.

Note: An exhibit which has gained sufficient awards to qualify for the title

Open Jumping

For dogs of either sex which have qualified and applied for the title of Jumping Dog (JD) or Jumping Dog Excellent (JDX)

Master Jumping

For dogs of either sex which have qualified and applied for the title of Jumping Dog Excellent (JDX) or Jumping Dog Master (JDM)

DEFINITION OF CLASSES: OBEDIENCE

Qualifications up to and including the date of closing of entry shall count as eligibility to compete in any Class.

Novice Class

For dogs, 6 months of age or over, and of either sex which are not eligible for the title of Companion Dog (CD).

Encouragement Class

For dogs that have already worked in Novice Class but not gained a Qualifying Score may enter the Encouragement Class.

Novice Competition

May be provided for dogs of any breed or either sex who have gained the title of Companion Dog (CD) and have not attained a qualifying score in Open Class.

Open Class

Open Competition

For dogs of any breed or either sex who have gained a qualification towards the title of Utility Dog (UD). Dogs with a qualification towards a UD title will be ineligible to enter the Open Class when an Open Competition is offered.

Utility Class

For dogs of either sex which have qualified for the title of Companion Dog Excellent (CDX) in Open Class.

Note: An exhibit which has gained sufficient awards to qualify for the title

Open Jumping

For dogs of either sex which have qualified and applied for the title of Jumping Dog (JD) or Jumping Dog Excellent (JDX)

Master Jumping

For dogs of either sex which have qualified and applied for the title of Jumping Dog Excellent (JDX) or Jumping Dog Master (JDM)

DEFINITION OF CLASSES: OBEDIENCE
