Courts Need a Scrub to Get up to Scratch

The Executive met with a tennis court maintenance specialist on Tuesday 31 March and he showed that the problem with the courts is not that they are worn. The issue is that the surface has been compacted and congealed. There is a simple cure. What needs to be done is the courts need a scrub to loosen the compacted surface.

Everyone can help!!!

When you next come to tennis bring your scrubbing brush (needs to have stiff bristles). Then during a break in the tennis you can scrub a small area to loosen the pile and remedy the situation. There have been a few test areas scrubbed already. See near the service line on court two. If everyone does a little the whole will be done in a very short time. If you forget to bring your own brush there are a couple of brushes in the locked room which any one can use. One is on a broom handle so is easy to use without bending.

After the initial scrubbing we can improve the maintenance regime so that the state of compaction never gets this bad in the future.
