



# Morley Panthers Rollerskating Club

## Artistic Rep Report – November 7, 2022

- At the Skate WA meeting on 17 October it was voted that Nationals will be hosted at the South West Sports Centre in Bunbury from 1-8 July 2023 with setup on 30 June. A Nationals working party is being established and anyone interested is encouraged to join. As a result of this it was stated that it would be very likely that States in 2023 will also be held in Bunbury.
- Skate Australia (AATC executive) decided that proficiency tests will not be a requirement to participate at Nationals in 2023. However they are encouraging skaters to undertake medal tests in case it becomes a Nationals requirement after 2023.
- Proficiency tests took place on Saturday 5 November at Kingsway for dance and free skate and Sunday 6 November at Morley for figures.
- The Development and Novice competition took place on Sunday 6 November at Kingsway, with figures at Morley. Five novice skaters and seven development skaters from Morley Panthers participated in the event, which was a very successful and enjoyable end to the competitive artistic calendar for 2022.
- The open day at Kingsway is still planned for Saturday 17 December, 10am-2pm. Details still TBA but possibly a table representing the sport and maybe some demo skating.
- Bunbury RSC circulated more details about the Gawaine Davis dance skate camp at the Rink in Bunbury in January. The dates of 7-9 January were confirmed as was the cost of \$20/class or \$100 for all classes (aimed at beginner, bronze, silver and gold level) and the availability of one private lesson per person at \$70 for 30 mins. A few Panthers members have expressed interest at this stage in participating but Bunbury RSC will not be sending out formal registration forms until Gawaine has booked his flights.
- The first version of the artistic skating calendar has been circulated. League 1 is a little earlier than usual (28/29 January) due to venue availability and so nominations for that will be closing on 16

December. Morley needs to book in its development competition and late March is looking likely but TBC in the next couple of weeks.
