PORTRAITURE

Think about your portraiture differently!

There are two main types of portraiture:

The first is Studio style portraits with controlled artificial lighting and clichéd poses.

The second is relaxed Photo-journalist style portraits taken at different locations using available natural light. I use this approach.

Learn how to focus on the essence of the subject — the essential elements that identify them as an individual — how to build a relationship of trust, how to capture emotion - or evoke emotion in the viewer — how to create images that are simple and minimalist excluding all unessential superfluous elements.

How to capture the magical moments of childhood innocence and naturalness — little people doing what little people do — creating images that have a strong emotive element about them.

It's not all about capturing the perfect smile!

There are so many occasions in life when we want to stop the clock. These are the moments we should be photographing!

TUTORING PROGRAMME

I offer a limited number of students one-on-one tutoring in portraiture, (specialising in babies and toddlers), travel photography, competition photography, *Adobe @ Photoshop, Lightroom* and Basic Camera Craft.

The programme depends on the individual and is flexible and designed according to their needs.

In the first session we work out a programme to suit the level, and desired level, of the photographer.

The areas we can include are:

- ◆ Tutoring in equipment, technique, style, composition, *Photoshop* and *Lightroom*.
- ◆ Feedback and discussion of the photographer's work with positive suggestions for improvement.
- ◆ Location shoots – again with feedback

- ◆ Sessions are preferably at my studio, on location, or you may choose to be at your home.
- ◆ Times and dates arranged to mutual agreement.
- ◆ Duration of sessions is determined by you. Though there is a minimum of one hour, longer sessions are normally more beneficial.
