

## **CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES 2008**

The Education Act 1999 requires schools to notify parents of the schedule of Contributions and Charges for the following year. The Wembley Primary School Council has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2008. The Schedule covers four sections and will allow you to calculate all costs for 2008.

### **1. Contributions**

- The contribution parents and carers are being asked to pay has been set at \$60.00. This is in line with the School Education Regulation 2000 and endorsed by the School Council. The School has set the Voluntary contribution at \$60.00 to ensure that we can broaden and maximize the educational opportunities for all of our students.
- Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the purchase of resources needed in the provision of the learning program activities, eg.

- While contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning program will be enhanced when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources including the State and Commonwealth Governments.

### **2. Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components:**

A breakdown of *estimated charges* for your child's participation in incursions, excursions, and other activities for 2008 has been included in the schedule below. Details on charges collected in previous years have informed our 2008 charges schedule. Students will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the maximum charge for scheduled activities in 2008. Costs of these activities are the responsibility of the parent. Cheque, cash or credit facilities are available. Term accounts are sent home at the end of week two. Payment is due by the end of week 4 and is to be returned to the classroom.

The **Charges Schedule** includes costs associated with:

- specific learning activities are available to **all** students, but conditional on a payment being made eg incursions, excursions, classroom cooking etc.
- specific learning activities are available to **selected** students, but conditional on a payment being made eg PEAC, School of Instrumental Music program etc.
- other activities are available to all students, but conditional on a payment being made eg school picnics, graduation dinner dance etc.

**NB:** a) Please note that not all children in the year level are involved in all the above activities eg. inter-school sporting teams, debating, music, PEAC, etc.

b) For in school and out of school excursions \$60.00 is the maximum any one class will pay many classes will not be required to expend that amount.

### **3. Personal Items for Student Use (Years 1 - 7)**

These are items that students need to own for their personal use in the educational program. The school has determined the list of items to be supplied for the following year, which has been submitted to the School Council for discussion and approval.

We have negotiated competitive prices for the materials on the list but you are not obliged to use our supplier. Your child will need to have the listed materials each school day so it may be necessary to replace some items such as pencils throughout the year.

The charge for personal use items will vary from student to student and includes:

- Pupil Requirements for all students and used in lessons eg stationary items, recorder, calculator etc. (refer Wooldridges requirements sheet).
- Pupil Requirements recommended, but not essential, for all students eg art shirt, tissues etc.
- Pupil Requirements for selected students and not directly part of the educational program eg Graduation T-Shirt, class photographs.

### **4. Voluntary Approved Funds**

The P&C funds assist the school in major projects and resources for special programs eg air conditioning, undercover refurbishment, computers in classrooms, and co-operative reading books. The support of our parents is really appreciated.
